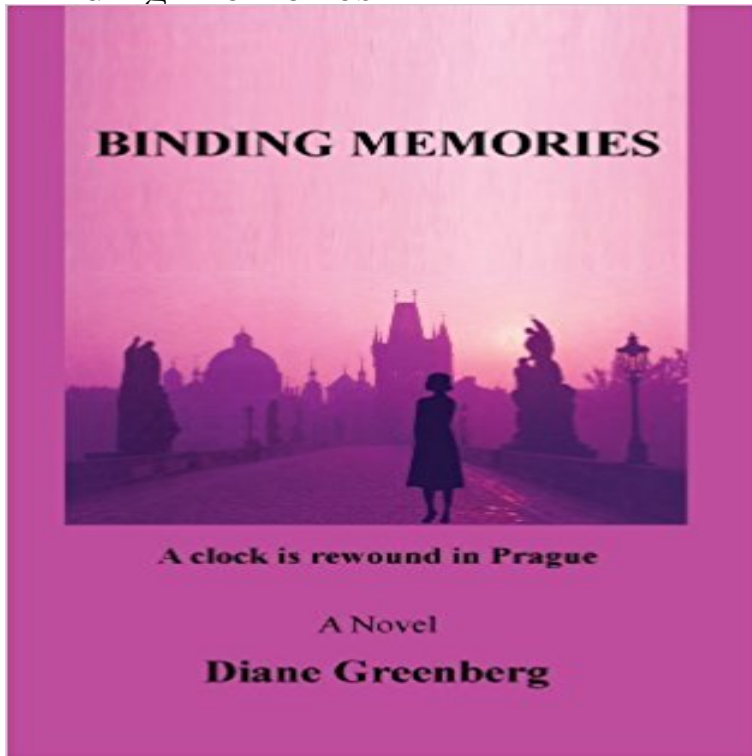


Binding Memories
