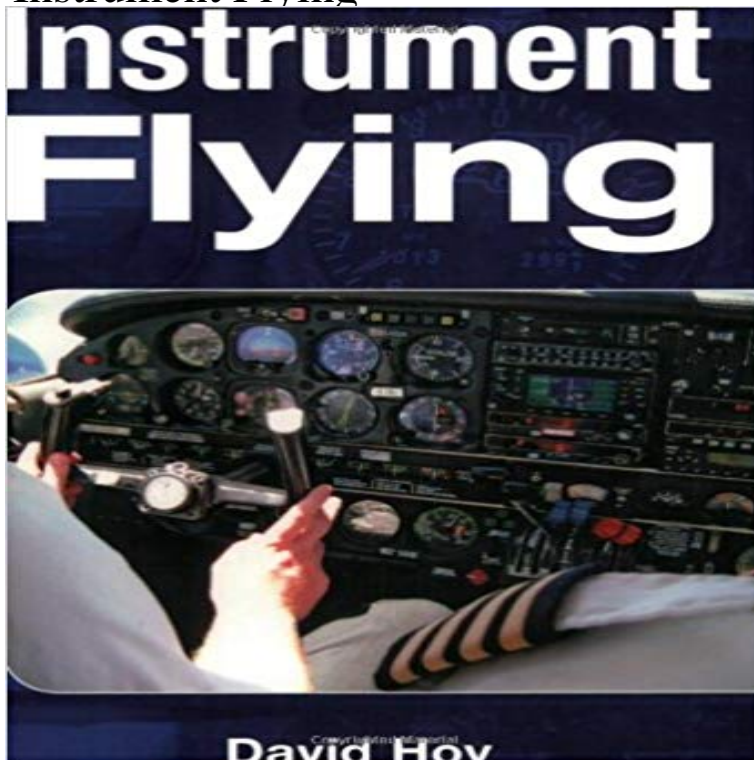


Instrument Flying
