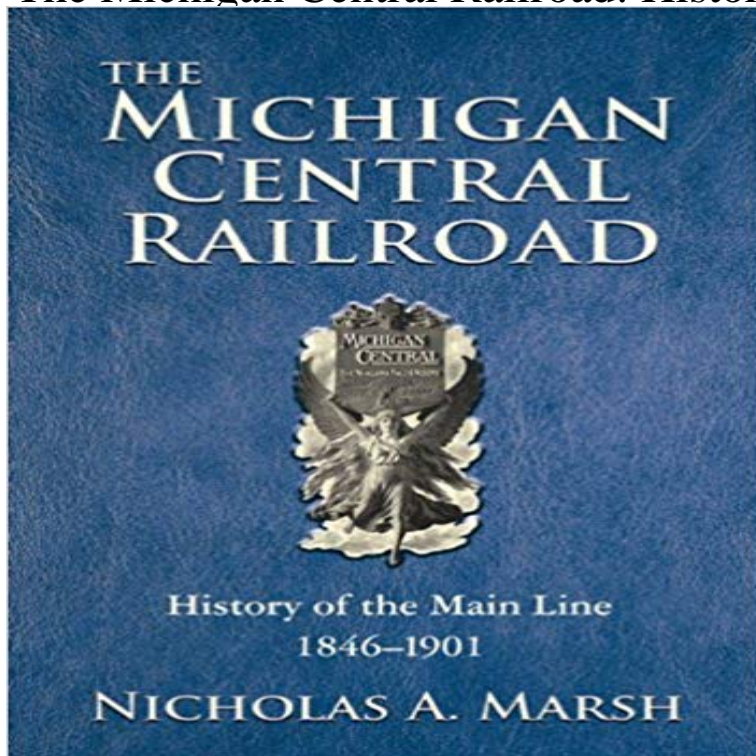


The Michigan Central Railroad: History of the Main Line 1846-1901
