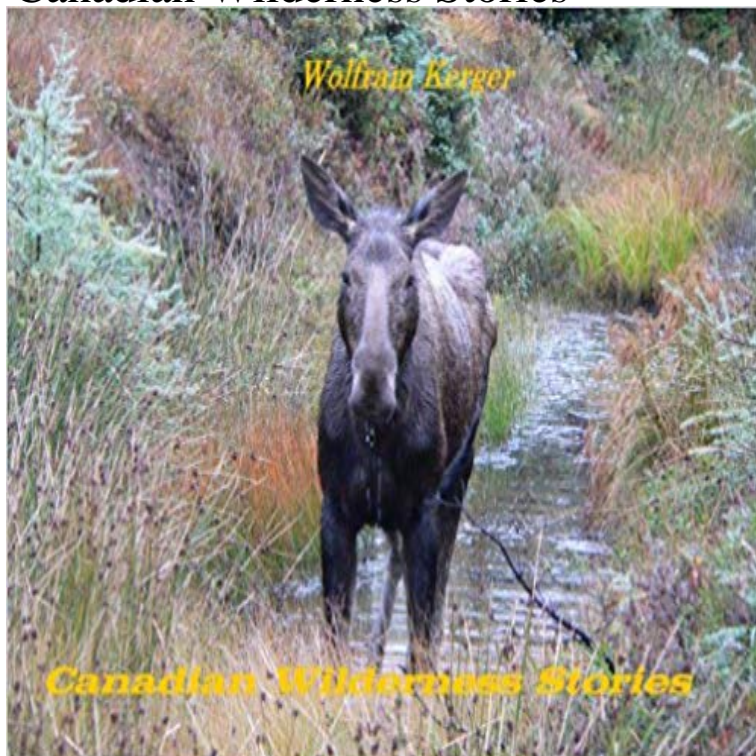


Canadian Wilderness Stories
