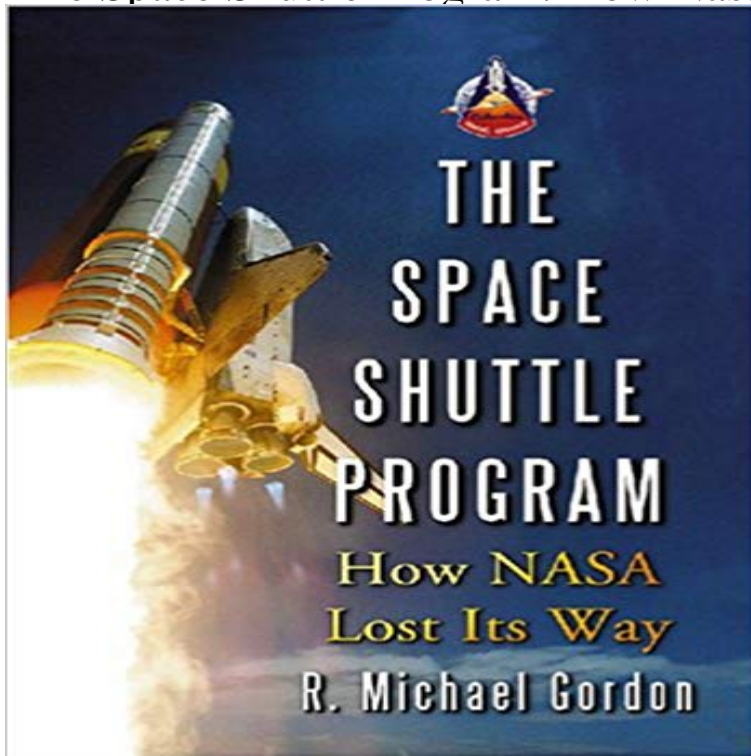


## The Space Shuttle Program: How Nasa Lost Its Way
